With Tax Cut Bill Passed, Republicans Call for More

LEAD PARAGRAPH - The \$350 billion package of tax cuts and state assistance approved by Congress today was still being printed when Republican leaders in Congress vowed to bring up more tax cut proposals later this year and extend today's measure for years to come.

"This ain't the end of it — we're going to have some more," said Representative Tom DeLay of Texas, the House majority leader, shortly before the 1:45 a.m. vote in which the House approved the tax plan. "Our budget says we're going to have \$1.3 trillion in tax cuts, and you bet we're coming back for more."
